International Student Fees and Expenses

1. ANNUAL TUITION

This fee covers all course fees, textbook loan and curriculum based trips (GST inclusive)

\$13,161.00

2. OTHER SCHOOL RELATED EXPENSES

This will vary according to individual student programme and interests

- a) External Examination Fee/s (if applicable)
National Certificate in Educational Achievement (N.C.E.A.)
Levels 1, 2 & 3 and University Scholarships

OTHER COSTS:

- b) Uniform compulsory. The cost varies according to year level and gender
- c) Club activities, musical instrument hire, specialised music tuition, outdoor education & other optional activities
- d) Stationery and other subject related costs are determined by subject choice.

3. HOMESTAY

- As our school borders on a rural area, accommodation can be arranged locally, within town or on a farm.
- Transport will be arranged from the airport to school or the student's Homestay
- There is an annual **Homestay Arrangement Fee of \$200.00**. This payment includes the services of the Homestay Coordinator who is available to assist in any cases of misunderstanding or difficulties in the Homestay situation.

NB: This is compulsory for all students under the age of 18.

- **Homestay Accommodation payments are set at \$180.00 per week** for a fully furnished single room, all meals, heating, laundry etc. per annum. If a student returns home for the school holidays they will be eligible for a refund calculated against each full week of absence.

Homestay fees are to be paid in advance either for the whole year or quarterly.

4. GUARDIAN SERVICE

A guardian service is provided by the school. The guardian will oversee the student's welfare and will have the power to act on the behalf of the parents in matters relating to the student while he/she is living in New Zealand. **\$ 2000.00**

5. ADMINISTRATION / PASTORAL CARE

An administration / pastoral care fee will be charged per student **\$1000.00**

6. INSURANCE

Health and travel insurance is compulsory for the duration of a student's stay in New Zealand. This documentation needs to be sighted by the school prior to or on arrival to New Zealand.
